**Mine visit:** Goldcorp's *Borden Mine Project*

**Purpose:** *To visit the Goldcorp's Borden Mine Project, Canada's first all-electric underground gold mine. The Borden Gold Project site is located immediately north and east of Borden Lake, approximately 11 kilometres (km) northeast of Chapleau, Ontario and 160 km southwest of Timmins, Ontario. It is adjacent to, and directly accessible, by Ontario Provincial Highway 101.*

**Notes:**

1. The maximum number of people on the mine visit is 10.
2. Delegates should be physically able to do some walking, and assume all risk of injury, loss or damage.
3. Visitor coverall, and belt size must be provided prior to the mine visit. On safety boot size, if you wish to bring your own safety boots, it is permitted; otherwise, boots will be provided as close to requested size as possible.
4. Please send a copy of the completed registration form by September 14, 2018, and preference will be given to those attending the conference. The field trip registration fee of \$350 per person and includes all above transportation, Lunch and dinner on September 30 and lunch and dinner on October 1 (the fee is reduced to \$150 per person if you do not need the MDEC transportation).
5. It is suggested that delegates stay at Aux Trois Moulins/Riverside Hotel in order to leave early the next morning by bus to the mine site. Delegates are responsible to make their own hotel reservation at the 1-705-864-1313, by cut-off date of September 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018, and must specify the "MDEC" to access negotiated rate of (CND \$134 per room plus applicable taxes).
